Some suggestions given by the Assessment Team are hereunder for further improvement of your nursery.

Suggestions:-

1. A metallic board showing the nursery layout plan should be installed at the entrance gate indicating different blocks, total area under nursery and mother plant blocks with total number and name of varieties of different fruit crops.

2. Mother plants available in the nursery should be duly numbered/marked crop and variety wise for identification.
3. Proper tagging should be done in respect of fruit, variety and number while selling/ supplying the planting materials.
4. Flow-chart/calendar of operation should be maintained systematically in the nursery.
5. All nursery records/registers should be duly maintained and should be kept in the nursery at the time of inspection.
6. All required infrastructures like shade- nets, poly- house, drip/ sprinkler irrigation system, fertigation unit misting unit, soil/ media sterilization facilities, tissue culture facilities etc. should be developed in the nursery.
7. Nurseryman should develop its own root-stock blocks with their performance record.
8. Nursery field staffs including nursery in charge should be given hands on training from any authentic SAU/ ICAR institute regarding all operations of nursery and new propagation techniques.
9. Proper care of mother plants such as application of manures, fertilizers, chemicals and inter-culture operation should be done frequently as per need.
10. The nursery area is required to keep neat and clean always by removing all unwanted weeds, bushes, wild grasses by inter culture operations or by use of weedicides.
11. There is need to enhance /create the facilities for soil sterilization (By steam as well as solar) for sterilizing the soil/media to raise nursery plants in containers like poly bags or Pots etc.
12. The bud-wood should be taken from the promising, healthy and disease free plants.
13. Bill book should be properly maintained in the nursery.
14. Utmost care should be taken to produce healthy plants.
